



YCP SUMMER HOUSING TERMS 2026

Assignments

Housing for the summer term will be located in Spring Garden Apartments on West Campus. The rate for summer housing is \$245 per week. All assignments are within double occupancy rooms.

Air Conditioners

Students wishing to bring an air conditioner must indicate that on the housing application. The additional cost is \$35 per week and will be billed separately from the housing charges. The air conditioner must be a stand-alone, self-evaporating unit, no larger than 8,000 BTUs. Students are responsible for the installation and maintenance of the air conditioning unit.

Eligibility

Only students who are enrolled for an in-person course or internship for academic credit will be approved to live in campus housing during the summer term. If an in-person course is cancelled or converted to online, students will be required to check out of their on-campus summer housing assignment within 24 hours of the in-person course change.

Meals and Kitchen

Each student apartment has a kitchen that includes a full-size refrigerator/freezer, oven, stove, and cabinet space. Students may bring a microwave as long as it falls within the College guidelines of up to 700 watts. One microwave per apartment is permitted.

Personal Property

York College of Pennsylvania is not liable for loss or damage to personal property occurring while a student resides in College-owned housing. Renter's insurance is suggested. YCP will NOT provide temporary storage between semesters.

Property Care

Residents are responsible for the care and cleaning of their apartment as well as the common area for the apartment complex. A resident may not install equipment, make alterations, or make repairs.

Refunds

Subletting

York College of Pennsylvania regulations strictly prohibits the subletting of any College living facilities.

YCP Policies and Procedures

As a summer resident of York College of Pennsylvania, the resident agrees to abide by all College policies and procedures as outlined in the College Catalog, Student Handbook, and Student Code of Conduct. These policies pertain to but are not limited to alcohol, illegal drugs and paraphernalia, pets, use of motor vehicles, general student conduct, and emergencies. Summer Opening and Closing Information

- **Residence halls close on Thursday, May 7, 2026. Students with spring housing assignments will be required to check out in accordance with College policy.**
- Move in for Entire Summer and Summer Session I will be on Sunday, May 24, 2026, beginning at noon.
- Summer Session I students will need to check out by 9 pm on Friday, July 3, 2026.
- Move in for Summer Session II will be on Sunday, July 5, 2026, beginning at noon.
- Entire Summer and Summer Session II students without Fall 2026 housing assignments will need to check out by 9 pm on Friday, August 14, 2026. No exemptions will be granted.
- Students who have housing assignments in Fall 2026, are able to move directly from Summer II or Entire Summer housing into fall housing assignments, during timeframe specified by the Office of Residence Life.
